Day 3, September, 1st



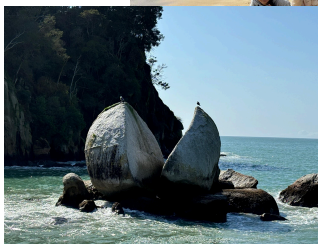
### Walking around Motueka Town
